







International faculty, staff and researchers connect UT to a global research network, fill vital gaps in expertise and promote the university's global presence.






EXCHANGE VISITORS | FALL 2023



EXCHANGE VISITORS BY TYPE




TOP 7 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN



IMMIGRATION SPONSORSHIP SUPPORT | FALL 2023

International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS) files H-1B petitions on behalf of academic colleges. This directly saves the cost of outside counsel as a service to academic units. During fiscal year 2023, ISSS filed 51 new petitions and 32 extensions saving the University of Tennessee \$217,000 in additional costs.
