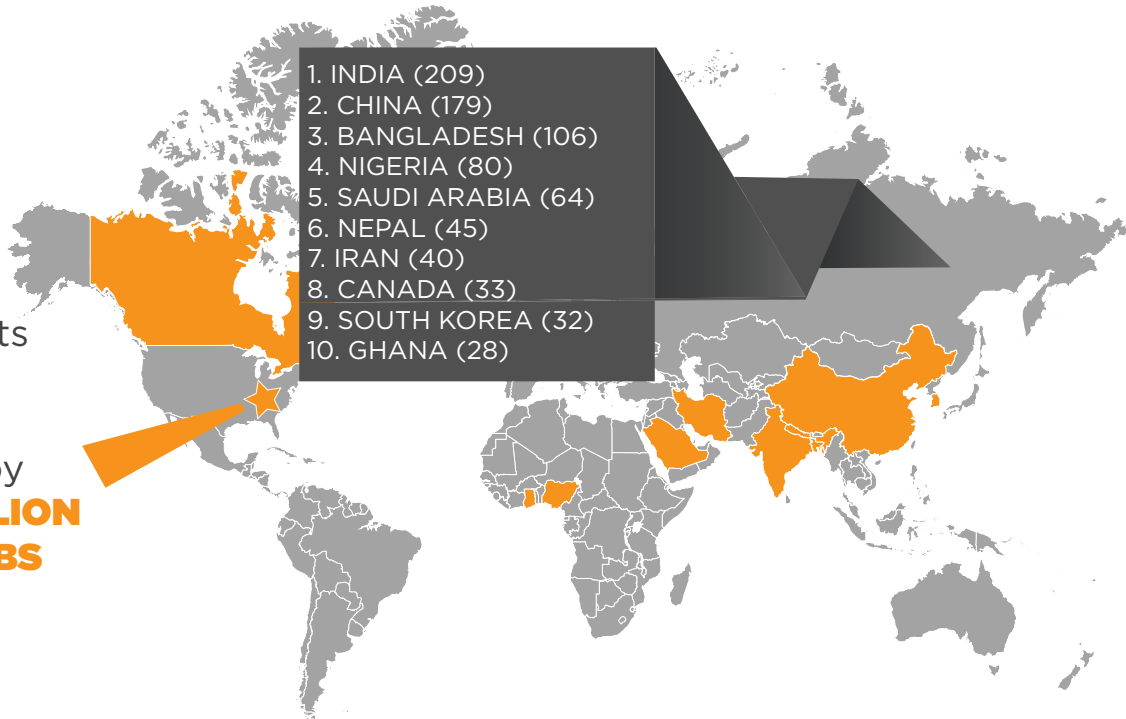

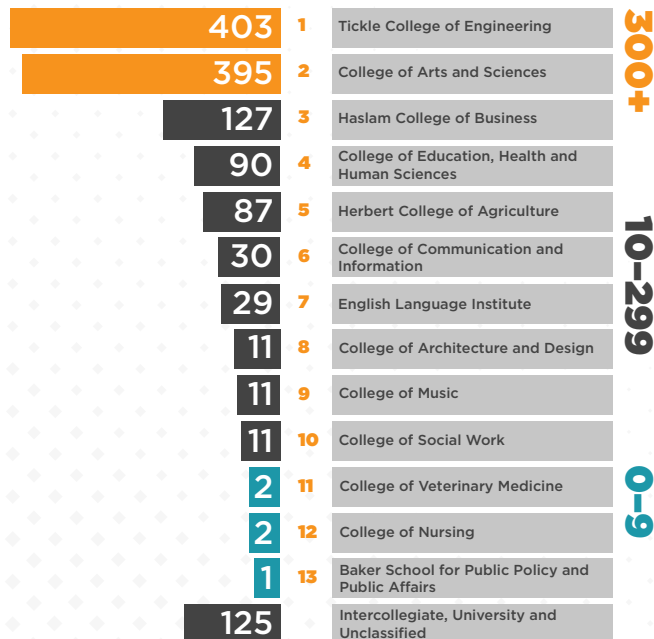

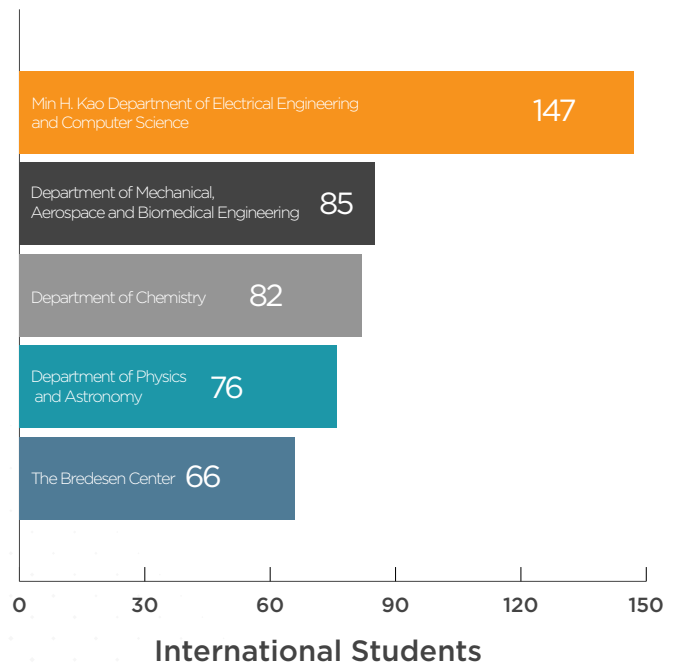

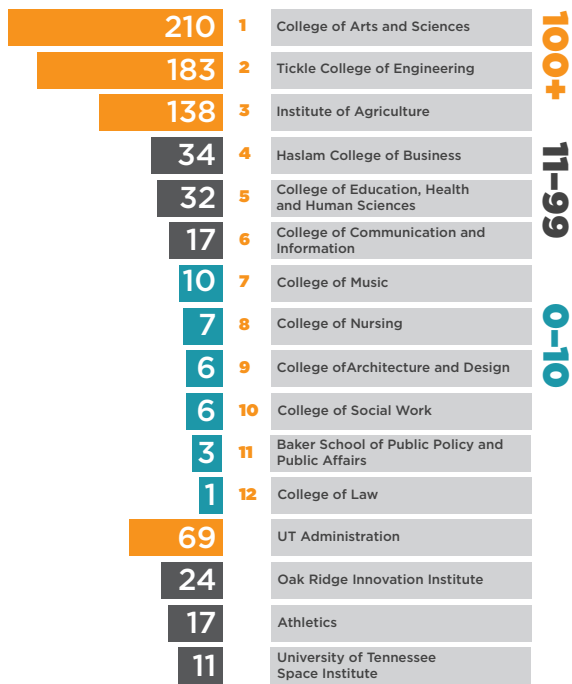

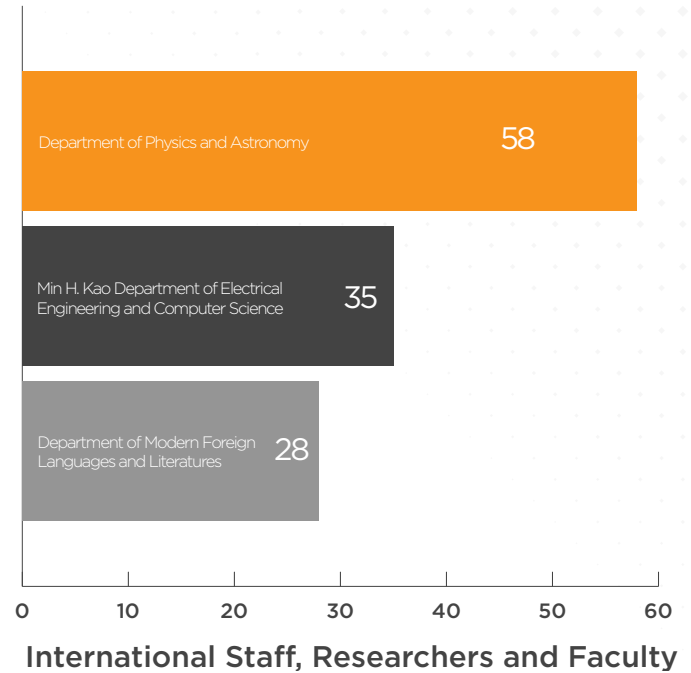

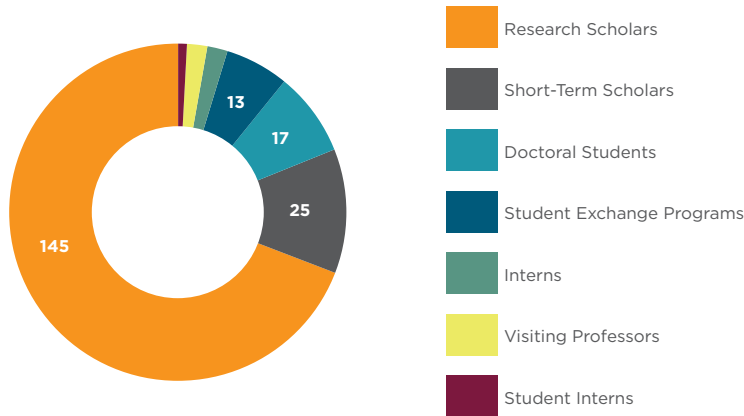


EXCHANGE VISITORS | SPRING 2024

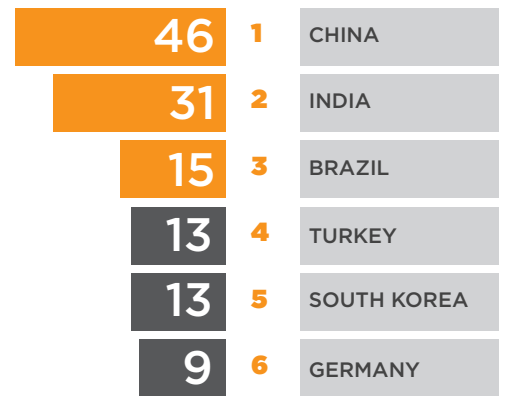

TOP 6 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN

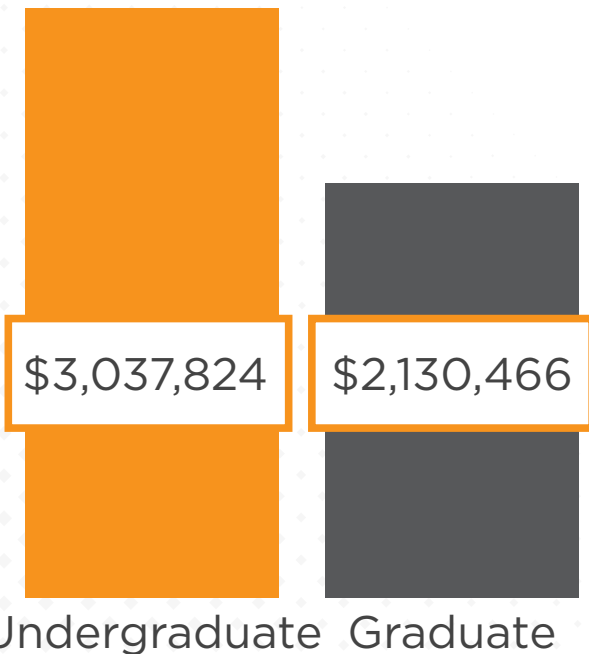


NON-UT FUNDED STUDENTS REVENUE | SPRING 2024

These fee-paying students are self-sponsored or funded by foreign governments and organizations, bringing tuition and fee dollars that help support the work done at the university. Fee-paying international students bring **\$5,168,290** in tuition and fees revenue to the university.
